DEBRA MAJOR

Debra Major received a B.A. in Psychology and Communication from Michigan State University and a Ph.D. in Psychology with a focus in Industrial/Organizational Psychology from Michigan State University. She joined Old Dominion as Assistant Professor of Psychology in 1992, achieved the rank of Professor in 2005 and was designated an Eminent Scholar in 2014. Recognition of her accomplishments in teaching, research and service include the Distinguished Contributions Award from the Society for Industrial and Organizational Psychology, Fellow status American Psychological Association, Fellow status Association for Psychological Society, ODU Champion of Diversity Award, ODU Faculty Research Achievement Award, ODU Provost's Award for Outstanding Undergraduate Teaching, and many additional awards.

Major has served as the major professor for 17 doctoral students who completed their Ph.D. at Old Dominion University as well as chaired numerous master's theses. Her administrative experience includes serving as Associate Dean for the College of Science (2018), Graduate Program Director in the Department of Psychology (2018), Director of the I/O Undergraduate Research Apprenticeship Program at ODU, and Associate Chair for Research for the Department of Psychology (2010-18).
