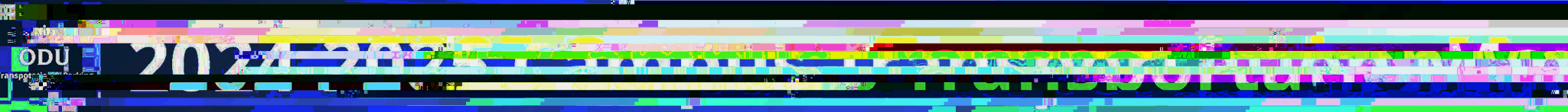

# Parking

All on-campus parking requires a valid ODU Parking Permit or hourly parking payment. ODU utilizes a virtual permit system and Virginia State Recognition (VSR) to enforce regulations.

## Student Parking

Freshman and Upper Level students are required to purchase a parking permit in order to park a vehicle on campus. ODU Commuter and Resident permits are semester permits. Monthly, Weekly, & Daily permit options are also available. See front of map for the QR code to parking for maps for each permit type.

## Faculty/Staff

Faculty/Staff Permits are renewed annually and can be purchased online at [odu.edu/parking](http://odu.edu/parking). Monthly, Weekly, & Daily permit options are also available. See our website for Faculty/Staff parking locations.

## Short Term Parking

Daily, Weekly, & Monthly Permits are available to anyone parking on campus and are valid in any Faculty/Staff, Commuter, or Resident location and can be purchased online at [odu.edu/parking](http://odu.edu/parking).

## ADA Accessible Parking

Accessible parking spaces are located throughout campus. State-issued accessible parking placards must be accompanied by a valid ODU parking permit or Hourly Permit.

## Citations & Appeals

Citations will be issued for violations of ODU IPS Rules & Regulations (available online at [odu.edu/parking](http://odu.edu/parking)). Appeals MUST be submitted within 10 business days of citation date. If an appeal is denied, payment is required.

Booting or towing a vehicle without a permit or payment may be booted and/or towed at the driver's expense.

## Motorcycle and Bicycle

Two-wheeled motor vehicles require a permit and must be parked in the designated striped and signed areas in garages and parking lots. Motorcycles and bicycles are not permitted in garages. Bicycles and bicycles may be purchased at the TDS Office. All garages have motorcycle and bicycle parking spaces.

## Hourly & Daily Short Term Parking

After parking your vehicle, pay immediately using a mobile app on your mobile device or via pay station. Payment may be made using a credit card, debit card, or cash. Payment is required before leaving the lot.

## Visitor Parking

Pay station visitor lot 7. Visitor lot 7 is located at the intersection of 43rd St & Baker St. Constant Center 43rd & 45th St Garages. 49th St Student Garage.

## Event Parking

Event parking permits must be made at least 1 week in advance.

# Transportation

## Monarch Transit SafeRide

Transportation & Parking Services offers transportation on-campus, as well as on-campus destinations with Monarch Transit Shuttles. ODU is not required to board children transit.

## SafeRide

With SafeRide you can travel safely and comfortably instead of walking. Routes are available between Magnolia Ave (North) and 38th Street (South), as well as the Elizabeth Over West and Long Ave East. ODU ID is required to board SafeRide.

## Transloc App

Download the Transloc App to track Monarch Transit Shuttles in real time and request SafeRide ride information. SafeRide MUST be requested through the Transloc App.



## Project 529 Bike Registration

Free bike registration is available at ODU. Register your bike online at [project529.com](http://project529.com) or download the Project 529 mobile app to register your bike. After registration, please come to the TDS Office with your registration to receive your license plate and U-Tag.
